Read Around the Planet (RAP) is a celebration of reading. TWICE provides the registration tool, matches classrooms with partners and provides support documents. Participating classrooms are responsible for their video connection and developing their own reading activities.

This activity is open to all PreK-12 students (ages 4-18) in public and private schools who have access to two-way interactive video equipment (H.323). Participate in English or another category: Spanish, English as a Second Language or Special Education.

Your class will be matched with a class from a different location, and each class will exchange reading activities. Spanish, ESL or Special Ed classes will be matched in the same category, but may not be the same grade level.

10 min. Q&A exchange about schools & communities

10 min. Extra time in case of connection issues
